**(Galatians 6:7 PHILLIPS)** Don't be under any illusion: you cannot make a fool of God! A man's harvest in life will depend entirely on what he sows.

- ✓ \_\_\_\_\_ – is to look a person in the eye in their moment of impossibility and take their needs on as your own.
- ✓ \_\_\_\_\_ – the state of being inferior in quality or insufficient in amount. (something missing or lack of some kind)

***The Law of Multiplication***

**(Luke 9:12-17 NKJV)** When the day began to wear away, the twelve came and said to Him, "Send the multitude away, that they may go into the surrounding towns and country, and lodge and get provisions; for we are in a deserted place here." (13) But He said to them, "You give them something to eat." And they said, "We have no more than five loaves and two fish, unless we go and buy food for all these people." (14) For there were about five thousand men. Then He said to His disciples, "Make them sit down in groups of fifty." (15) And they did so, and made them all sit down. (16) Then He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke them, and gave them to the disciples to set before the multitude. (17) So they all ate and were filled, and twelve baskets of the leftover fragments were taken up by them.

***Three Principles of Multiplication:***

1. What you have must be \_\_\_\_\_ before it can multiply.

### ***Three Principles of Multiplication:***

1. What you have must be **blessed** before it can multiply.
  - ✓ The **tithe** belongs to God.
  - ✓ Tithing is not **sowing**. Tithing is **returning**.
  - ✓ Only what you give over your tithe is **seed** and can be multiplied.

2. It is the blessing of Jesus that gives it the potential to **multiply**.
