(Joshua 14:10-11 NKJV) And now, behold, the LORD has kept me alive, as He said, these forty-five years, ever since the LORD spoke this word to Moses while Israel wandered in the wilderness; and now, here I am this day, eighty-five years old. (11) As yet I am as strong this day as on the day that Moses sent me; just as my strength was then, so now is my strength for war, both for going out and for coming in.

✓ **Coming In** – You came in to be refreshed and refilled from war in the Presence of the Lord.

✓ **Going Out** - You went out from the Presence of the Lord for battle.

1. Let's continue to **come in**.

(Jeremiah 17:19-22 NKJV) Thus the LORD said to me: "Go and stand in the gate of the children of the people, by which the kings of Judah come in and by which they go out, and in all the gates of Jerusalem; (20) and say to them, 'Hear the word of the LORD, you kings of Judah, and all Judah, and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, who enter by these gates. ✓ Leave your **burdens** in the Presence of God!

(Ezekiel 46:9 NKJV) "But when the people of the land come before the LORD on the appointed feast days, whoever enters by way of the north gate to worship shall go out by way of the south gate; and whoever enters by way of the south gate shall go out by way of the north gate. He shall not return by way of the gate through which he came, but shall go out through the opposite gate.

✓ Whoever comes in to worship one way should go out **another way**.

(Ezekiel 46:10 NKJV) The prince shall then be in their midst. When they go in, he shall go in; and when they go out, he shall go out.

✓ We should not go out **FROM** the Presence of God; we should go out **WITH** the Presence of God.
