1. Connect with God \_\_\_\_\_.

"Our Father in Heaven"

**(Romans 8:15 NLT)** So you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when He adopted you as His own children. Now we call Him, "Abba, Father."

2. Worship \_\_\_\_\_.

"Hallowed be Your Name"

**(Proverbs 18:10 MSG)** GOD's name is a place of protection-- good people can run there and be safe.

**(Philippians 2:9-11 NKJV)** (9) Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, (10) that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, (11) and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

3. Pray \_\_\_\_\_ first.
