### ***Prayer that Brings Results!***

1. Find out what God's Word says about your situation and **base your prayer** on God's Word.

2. Ask God for things you desire and believe that you **have the answer**.

**(Mark 11:24 NLT)** I tell you, you can pray for anything, and if you believe that you've received it, it will be yours.

3. **Meditate** constantly on the promises upon which you based the answer to your prayer.

**(Proverbs 4:20-21, 25-27 NKJV)** My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. (21) Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; (25) Let your eyes look straight ahead, And your eyelids look right before you. (26) Ponder the path of your feet, And let all your ways be established. (27) Do not turn to the right or the left...

4. Let your words **affirm** that you have what you ask.

**(Hebrews 4:14 AMPC)** Inasmuch then as we have a great High Priest Who has [already] ascended and passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession [of faith in Him].
